

Campsites

Q When do the campsites open

A Thursday until Monday. Please note, the campsite marshals and security staff are not present after the racing has finished on Sunday so it you are recommended not to leave any valuables in your tent if you leave the site for dinner, etc.

Q How big are the pitches

A Normal size is 7m x 5m which is enough for 1 car and a tent. If you want more space you are able to buy multiple pitches.

Q We are part of a group. How can we set our pitches up?

A If you are in a group and have pitches next to each other you can set your area out how you want; 1 car and tent per pitch or all tents together and the cars parked together in the remaining space.

Track session

Q When will the session be?

A The exclusive TVRCC session will be on Friday evening during a break in Practice and Qualifying. The exact time is still to be confirmed by the organisers, we will let everyone know when we have more information.

Q Is there a noise limit?

A No.

Q Are helmets compulsory?

A No.

Q Is a special licence needed?

A No.

Q Is there a speed limit?

A No, the only rule is that you cannot overtake the pace car, but this does go at a "reasonable" pace...

Q I have not attended a track day before. What is the pace of these sessions?

A This is not a track day, the laps are part of a "parade". However you are free to go at whatever speed you are comfortable with and racing is not allowed. If you are concerned about the speed of other cars the track is wide so there is plenty of room for everyone to go at their own pace.

Q Are we able to erect our own gazebos, region banners etc?

A Privately or club owned gazebos are not allowed, they must be hired from and erected by the event organisers. However club flags, banners and display/information boards are allowed.

Tickets

Q What are the deadlines for ordering tickets?

A We are limited to 200 cars in the Clubs Enclosure. Priority will be given to those members wishing to take part in the track session, any remaining passes will then be made available:

- 3rd January – Lap passes on sale with entrance tickets and "extras"
- 31st January – Lap passes on sale on their own or with entrance tickets and "extras"
- 15th February – Deadline for ordering lap passes
- 15th March – Final deadline for ordering entrance tickets and "extras"

General

Q What is the timetable for the weekend?

A As soon as we have confirmation of this from the event organisers we will let everyone know. In 2010 Practice & Qualifying sessions took place from 15.00 Friday until 02.00 Saturday. Racing started at 16.00 Saturday and finished at 16.00 Sunday.

Q What is the format of the racing?

A The cars are split into different groups depending on their age (in 2010 there were 6 groups). Each group races 3 times over the 24 hour period. As one group comes off the track the next roll onto the grid behind them so the breaks between each race is very short.

Q Do Radio Le Mans broadcast at the Classic?

A Yes, the regular team from the 24hr race will be there.
